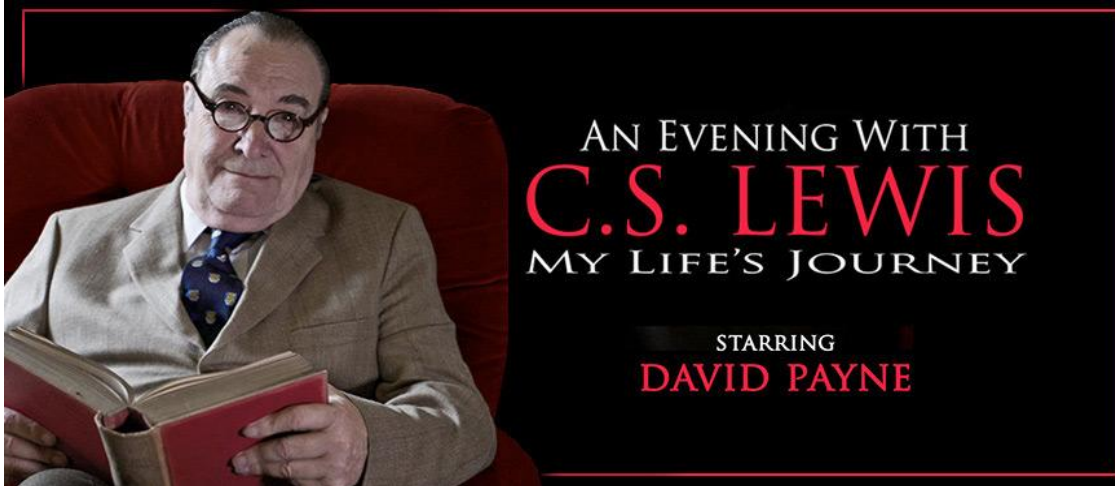

All-Night Vigil has been described as the last great crowning achievement of Russian Orthodox choral music. Nine of the fifteen movements are based on Orthodox chants, including some of the ancient Znamenny chants and more recent Greek and Kievian-style chants.
